One of the nursing home facilities has “adopted” us and we were asked to sing to their residents. Thankfully, a couple of our volunteers have beautiful voices and Von Rhodes has the gift of musical instruments. They told us it is difficult to get groups to come in to minister to their residents and it is always a highlight for them as they are lonely and often feel forgotten. It brought a smile to their faces and ours as they eagerly participated in singing well known hymns.



Looking ahead to a new year, we are excited of the open doors that God will bring our way to impact the children, teens and seniors who are broken, vulnerable, and seek the comfort and hope that can only be found in Jesus.
